Top Tips.

- Your ski jacket is the heaviest item in your luggage. To reduce the weight of your suitcase you could wear your jacket at the airport.
- You will need to photocopy your insurance policy, so each person named on the policy can carry it with them whilst skiing.

Baggage Allowance

Please check, very carefully, the weight of your hold suitcase. In recent years some airlines have started to charge large amounts, even for a few kilos of extra weight. Please check your E Ticket (or airline website) for your baggage allowance.

General guide-lines

Ski resorts are very relaxed about dress. You don't need any "posh" clothing, although most hotels and restaurants would ask that you wear smart casual clothing for dinner, so gentlemen may wish to pack a warm shirt or two.

Ski Carriage

If you have paid for ski carriage this will be shown on your E Ticket. You should ensure that your skis/board is securely packed in a suitable bag.

Multiple Flights

If you are taking more than one flight to Italy (e.g., via Gatwick or Amsterdam) you should ask the check-in staff to ensure that your bags are sent through to your final destination.

Baggage Tag

As a security measure, you are advised not to put your home address on your baggage tag for the outwards flights. You should complete the homewards section just before departure from the resort.
